

****RESOLUTION OF THE MASSACHUSETTS REPUBLICAN PARTY ON
ELECTION INTEGRITY AND SIGNATURE VERIFICATION PROCESSES****

WHEREAS, the Massachusetts Republican Party is committed to upholding the highest standards of integrity, transparency, and fairness in all aspects of the electoral process; and

WHEREAS, during the 2026 election cycle, irregularities were identified in the collection, verification, and certification of nomination signatures for multiple statewide Republican candidates; and

WHEREAS, these irregularities were appropriately reported by local election officials to the Secretary of the Commonwealth, prompting review by the State Ballot Law Commission and related legal proceedings ensued; and

WHEREAS, any attempt to manufacture fraudulent signatures by individuals or entities involved in the electoral process undermines public trust and must be treated as a serious violation of law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Massachusetts Republican Party:

- **Supports** the fair and transparent resolution of these matters through appropriate administrative processes and the courts;
- **Calls for** a thorough and timely investigation into any alleged fraud or irregularities in the signature collection process;
- **Urges** the State Auditor to conduct a comprehensive review of the Commonwealth's signature verification and certification procedures to ensure uniformity, accuracy, and adherence to best practices; and
- **Reaffirms** its commitment to free, fair, and transparent elections and to restoring public confidence in candidate nomination and ballot access systems.
